Registration, Participation and Starting Allowance:

According to §7 and §10 of the general competitions rules of the Austrian Swimming Federation. Non-Austrian clubs declare with the registration that they belong to a national federation of the FINA and that all registered athletes possess the right to start for the club. A permission of the national federation to start abroad has to be presented.

With the handed in registrations the clubs reassure that the registered swimmers can prove their health and that the health testing is not older than 12 months from the registration deadline.

Registration:

Have to be conducted via LENEX File or online under <http://www-cis-online.net>. The registration times will be taken automatically from the Online-System of the OSV. Only times that have been swum in a 50m pool from the 1st of April 2015 are going to be considered. The LENEX file can be downloaded under the following link: <http://www.msecm.at>

Entry fees:

Individual: 5,00€ per event / Relay: 6,00€ per relay.

The entry fees are going to be prescribed to the club separately.

There is no facility of payment at the competition, **except non-Styrian Masters.**

Penalty fee:

According to § 105 (g) of the OSV competition rules (is going to be invoiced by the Styrian Swim Federation after the competition)

Mixed Relay:

According to § 110 (g) of the OSV competition rules (mixed relays consist of 2 female and 2 male participants).

Awards:

Places 1 to 3 of the ranking across age groups will receive a medal. There is a separate evaluation for Juniors, Youths and Followers (except of the 50m events).

Medals are only going to be distributed to the persons attending the ceremony. By not attending the ceremony the club will have to pay 20€.

Masters regulation, rankings and awards:

Place 1 to 3 with the highest individual performance points (respectively males and females age group and event overlapping), assessed by the DSV Masterstable 2015 (that has an age group overlapping point system) will receive medals.

The 3 best Styrian participants are going to be counted for the Styrian Masters Championships; a double-award for international Masters Championship is not going to be provided.

The Masters Victory Ceremony is going to take place after event nr.60.

Referee: Is going to be nominated by the Styrian Swimming Federation.

Competition judges:

For each session each **styrian** club has to provide judges.

Up to 5 participants – 1 judge

6 and more participants – 2 judges

The announcement of the judges has to be made in the course of the registration. If a club does not provide a judge the club has to pay a penalty fee **of 50€** for each session.

Youth Relays:

The organizer allows oneself to make a break after event Nr. 6, 4x100m Individual Medley for Youths.

Masters Heats:

If there is only one starter/participant in a masters event, the organizer can put female and male masters events together.
